

Impact of Catch Up Premium 2014/2015

In September 2014 there were 15 students who came to us below level 4 in English and 19 in mathematics. Of these 9 were below level 4 in both subjects. The Catch Up Premium funding was used, principally to provide literacy and numeracy catch-up support for these children.

All students benefitted from small group teaching.

Of these students, 13 of the mathematics students and 8 of the English students were on our Purple Pathway benefitting from specialist teaching and in-class support.

96% of year 7 Catch Up students for English are on track to make 2 levels progress by the end of key stage 3. Of these, 83% have already made at least 1 level progress.

100% of year 7 Catch Up students for mathematics are on track to make 2 levels progress by the end of key stage 3. Of these, 72% have already made at least 1 level progress.

One of the students has left.
