4 Types of BULLYING

Physical Bullying

Hitting, kicking, slapping, pinching

Spitting

Tripping, pushing

Stealing or destroying someone's possessions

Making mean or rude hand gestures

Verbal Bullying

Name calling

Insults

Teasing

Intimidation

Homophobic, transphobic, biphobic or racist comments

Inappropriate sexual comments

Taunting

Threatening to cause harm

Social Bullying

Lying & spreading rumours

Leaving someone out on purpose

Telling others not to be friends with someone

Embarrassing someone in public

Damaging someone's social reputation or relationships

Cyber Bullying

Posting/sending hurtful texts, emails or posts, images or videos

Making online threats

Intimidating others online or using their log-in

Deliberately excluding others online

Spreading nasty gossip or rumours

At Maiden Erlegh we want to be clear about our expectations of **everyone** in the school community. This includes parents, students and staff.

What do I do if I believe I am being bullied?

What will the school do?

The school will investigate and intervene when bullying takes place on school premises, on the journey to and from school (whilst students are wearing uniform), off site activities and whilst using school equipment.

What happens if I am bullied outside of school?

The school will work together with parents when bullying is taking place offsite and provide advice to parents about what they can do to take appropriate action.
