Contacting the School

I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents how to contact the school. All members of staff can be contacted via the main school office email or switchboard number. If your query relates to a particular subject e.g. maths, then your questions should be directed to your child's maths teacher or to the Maths Department.

If you have a pastoral issue, then please contact your child's tutor in the first instance who will be happy to help and assist you in your query. You can contact your child's tutor by emailing reception and asking them to forward onto your child's tutor. All of the staff (including myself) have a significant teaching timetable and we are committed to responding to your email or telephone messages within 72 hours. Unfortunately, we are unable to meet with parents who come straight to reception without an appointment.

Intervention

You will have noticed a difference on the timetable this year with intervention classes being added onto the timetable. These are set up to rotate 5 times throughout the year with lots of subjects taking part and requesting students' presence on these lessons. We aim to only use PE (unless GCSE subject) twice in the year. We cannot take requests for certain sessions as these have already been allocated. Should your child wish to do one specifically I would ask that they come and speak to me themselves so I can explain next steps to them.
