Safe Drive Stay Alive – Monday 11 November 2019

'Safe Drive - Stay Alive' is an annual event organised by Thames Valley Police and is designed to raise awareness of road safety in the local area. It is aimed at Year 12 students and consists of a stage and film presentation, parts of which contain graphic images and themes which some students may find upsetting.

The event will be held at the Hexagon in Reading on Monday 11 November 2019 and the expectation is that all Year 12 students will attend. On this day students will follow their normal timetable until 12:15 pm, then they will assemble outside the parade of shops on Silverdale Road and travel to the venue by coach. We will return to school at approximately 3pm.

Students from Maiden Erlegh on trips and excursions are systematically complimented on their conduct and maturity. We expect Sixth Formers at this event to maintain this excellent reputation and represent the school in the best possible way.

With parental permission, students may make their own way home from the Hexagon but this must be indicated on the return form overleaf otherwise students will be expected to return to Maiden Erlegh School on the coach provided. Transport to and from the Hexagon Theatre will be paid for by the road safety partnership, although there is a booking fee of £1, per student, which we ask for as a voluntary contribution.
