Year 10 Religious Studies GCSE

I am writing to remind you that your son/daughter will be sitting their GCSE in Religious Studies in May this year. Year 10 have just completed their final Pre-Public Examination (PPE) for Religion and Philosophy and will be going through results with teachers, completing detailed improvement work to help students progress.

As outlined in the letter home in September, at Maiden Erlegh we are studying the new <u>Edexcel Religious</u> Studies B (1RBO), accredited by Ofqual in July 2016. This is formed of:

Paper 1: Religion and Ethics (1RBO/1C) from a Muslim perspective (1hr45). Topics: Belief in Allah, Marriage and the Family, Living the Muslim Life and Matters of Life and Death.

Paper 2: Religion, Peace and Conflict (1RBO/2B) from a Christian perspective (1hr45). Topics: Belief in God, Crime and Punishment, Living the Religious Life and Peace and Conflict.

If you wish to support your child further with their GCSE Religious Studies, we recommend:
