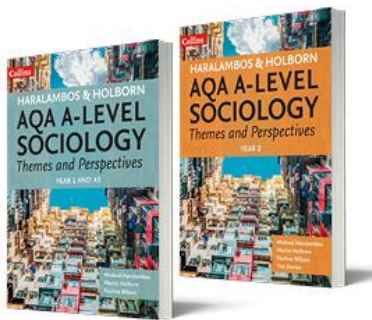




What text book should I consider buying?
