School Uniform and Equipment Reminder

As we near the end of term, I want to wish you a very happy and safe Christmas. We return to school on Monday 4 January and a couple of weeks ago I wrote to you about Equipment and Uniform expectations.

Despite the very challenging times, in which we all find ourselves we are keen to maintain the high standards of our school. Therefore can you please ensure that your child is:

- 1. Wearing the right uniform, on the right day (they should only be wearing PE kit on days with practical PE lessons)
- 2. Wearing black polishable shoes with their normal school uniform.
- 3. Equipped for learning, with a transparent pencil case to ensure staff can check this easily and safely each morning.
- 4. Carrying a face covering (and a spare), with a plastic bag for storage to wear whilst on the school site.
- 5. Carrying hand sanitizer to use at the start and end of all lessons and especially before consuming lunch.

We intend to take a very strict view of uniform and equipment infringements in the new year, in line with our behavior policy. We will communicate with you, when infringements occur and ask for your support in ensuring that students are dressed appropriately, are well equipped and ready to learn.

In these difficult times, we are aware that some families may find themselves in financial hardship or are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, if this is the case and prevents you supporting your child with the above then please contact the relevant Head of Year.
