# Year 8 GCSE Options - Further Information for Parents and Students

Inevitably given the current circumstances, we are having to adapt the process for the KS4 GCSE Options somewhat this year. I am therefore writing to give you further details of the options process and how you and your child will be able to receive the information and support to help in decision making.

Options Handbook, Subject Presentations, Options Pathways and Online Options Form An email will be sent on Friday 5 February which will provide a link to the options booklet and a link to presentations for each of the subjects that can be selected as an option.

If there are any difficulties with accessing the options booklet, a small number of printed copies will be made available from school reception. However, we would ask that you only come onto the school site to collect these if it is absolutely necessary, as per current government guidelines.

Also, on Friday 5 February, we will be sending a second email with details of your child's recommended options pathway, and a link to an online options form that must be completed and submitted by midday Friday 5 March.

#### **Spring Tracking Progress Report**

The latest report on your child's progress will be made available on Tuesday 9 February. It has been necessary to move this from the original date of Monday 8 February due to the delay to the Year 8 assessment week. This has also meant that we have moved the Options Evening to Thursday 11 February to provide time to discuss the GCSE options information and the spring tracking progress report with your child before the evening takes place.

# **Options Evening**

On Thursday 11 of February we will hold an online options evening at 6.00pm. Myself and Mr Gibson will share a presentation about the options process, explain the options and option pathways, and give advice on how to go about selecting subjects.

After this initial presentation, subject staff will be available on zoom to answer any questions you may have that have not been answered by the options handbook, subject presentations, or the presentation on the night. Further details on how to join this event will be provided in due course.

# **Progress Meetings**

On Tuesday 23 February & Thursday 25 February we will hold our Progress meetings on line. If you have a specific question or issue with options I will be available for appointments. Further details on this will be provided in due course.
