Year 12 - Prelims: 24 & 25 May

I am writing to you regarding your child's forthcoming prelims, which are to be held on Monday 24 and Tuesday 25 May 2021. There will be no lessons on these two days. Students have been informed via Google Classroom of the broad content and timings of their exams, to help focus their revision.

In order to support your child, students will not be set any substantial pieces of homework, other than revision, in the two weeks prior to their prelims. Additionally, the PSMSC programme during the Summer term will also examine revision and study skills.

We are providing this level of support as we want all of our students to fulfil their potential. All the evidence shows that students who perform well in their prelims go on to be successful at A level. Prelim results will be published on 28 June 2021, you will be able to access them on the Parent App from this date.

If a student falls short of their target grade by more than two grades, they will be expected to re-sit this exam, either fully or partially. These re-sits will take place on Tuesday 7 September 2021.
