### **England v Czech Republic at Wembley Stadium – Friday 22 March 2019**

As part of our programme of social and cohesion events and activities at Maiden Erlegh we will be running a trip to Wembley Stadium to watch England play Czech Republic in the European Championship Qualifying. This event will take place on Friday 22 March. We will leave at 4:15pm and arriving back to school at approximately 11:30pm. This trip was originally due to run for Year 10 and 11 but there are several spaces available so we are offering them to Year 9.

As it is a recreational trip there will be a charge of £39 to cover entry to the game and return coach travel for 40 students. Should you have any problems with this financial contribution, please do not hesitate to contact Mr Mackie via the school office in writing or leave a telephone message. If you are entitled to pupil premium then you can indicate that you would like to use this money by ticking the box on the expression of Interest form. If the number of students wanting to go exceeds the capacity behaviour points will be taken into account and then a random draw. A reserve list will also be created which will be used if anyone on the trip withdraws.

Students will need to **arrive at school at 4pm** so we can leave school promptly at 4:15pm. We will return at approximately 11:30pm, although due to traffic leaving Wembley this may vary. For this reason I would encourage your son/daughter to take their own mobile phone to contact you when we are on our way back to school, although this will be entirely at their own risk. No refreshments will be provided, so either a packed dinner or some spending money is recommended as there are a variety of catering facilities and souvenir shops at the ground. Please note that due to the nature of this venue, the cost of refreshments are more expensive than normal. You should be aware that students will be free to walk around our section of the ground in small groups and without the direct supervision of the accompanying staff.

**We will be using the medical and contact information on our system for your child. Should your child's medical circumstances have changed it is your duty to inform the school in writing or email [office@maidenerleghschool.co.uk](mailto:office@maidenerleghschool.co.uk) as soon as possible and before the day of departure.**
