About the course/workshop	<p>Explore the wonderful world of colour! This workshop aims to take you through simple colour-mixing techniques to enable you to paint with confidence. Have fun working through a range of exercises in a relaxed & informative way. Learn how to mix a huge range of colours from a small selection of paints. From colour swatches to creative compositions – this is a fun way to play with pigments, learn a little colour theory and create some mini works of art along the way!</p> <p>No experience needed, lots of demos and step-by-step instruction. You can work in watercolour, gouache or acrylics – the emphasis is on understanding colour rather than specific paint techniques.</p>	
What to bring	<p>Drawing pencil Acrylic paints: process cyan, process magenta, process yellow, titanium white OR Watercolours: phthalo blue, cadmium yellow light or lemon yellow, permanent rose, plus white gouache (Bring any other colours you may already have and would like to use) Brushes (whatever you have) Mixing palette Paper: Watercolour paper or mixed media paper or heavy cartridge (approx. 200gsm) Newspaper, old clothes / apron</p>
