About the course/workshop	<p>A fun day creating lively and colourful images on a flower theme using a variety of painting and simple printing techniques.</p> <p>Learn how to make your own stamps using a range of easily available materials including foam, polystyrene, pasta and vegetables! Then combine with some sploshy paint techniques using feathers, fingers and scraggy brushes, along with a bit of spattering and a doodle with dip pens!</p> <p>A relaxed creative workshop - no experience necessary (and you don't need to be able to draw!)</p>	
What to bring	<p>Heavy watercolour paper or mixed media paper as a base for your work. If you wish to work on fabric in addition to paper, feel free to bring calico or cotton – some of the techniques translate well to textiles.</p> <p>Drawing pencil, rubber, Posca pens if you have any (don't buy specially). Paintbrushes, mixing palette with flat area (a tear-off palette is fine), kitchen roll, water pot.</p> <p>Dip pen if you have one (not essential) – the tutor will bring some.</p> <p>Acrylic paints or tube watercolours – primary colours, black & white plus any others you may have (if using watercolours please bring a tube of white gouache)</p> <p>Things to make marks and print with e.g loo roll tubes, carrots, cotton buds, lolly sticks etc – whatever you have – tutor will also bring things.</p> <p>Old clothes / apron.</p>	
Materials for sale	<p>There will be a small materials charge of approx. £3.00 payable to the tutor for miscellaneous materials.....please bring cash as the tutor doesn't have card facilities.</p>
