About the course/workshop	Be prepared to free up and let go! Capture the freshness, vivacity and colour of flowers in a variety of acrylic techniques including loose fluid methods and more painterly impressionistic approaches. We will initially work through quick exercises looking at shape and form and explore gestural energetic mark-making to capture the impression of flowers. We will look at the use of negative space and drawn marks as a foil to the looseness of painting – this is not a botanical painting class! Lots of step-by-step demos & individual help a basic knowledge of acrylics is useful.		
What students should bring	 Inspiration - pots, jugs, vases of flowers Heavy watercolour paper x 2 sheets (approx. 350gsm) Cartridge paper for initial studies and exercises Soft drawing pencil, rubber, charcoal (tutor will bring some) Oil pastels or artists crayons such as Neocolour - whatever you have (don't buy specially – tutor will bring some) Acrylic paints – primaries plus any others you have – if buying specially just buy primary colours and white Paint markers such as Posca if you have them (don't buy specially) Mixing palette with a large flat area (plates are fine), Range of brushes (whatever you have – including some large ones and fine ones) Kitchen sponge, palette knife if you have one Kitchen roll, water pot, water spray bottle if you have one Old clothes / apron. Please bring a mask to comply with COVID risk assessments.
