- Ask students to explain an idea to you.
- Discuss issues with the student that they have met in Biology with ethical, moral or social considerations with the aim of helping them to evaluate ideas.
- Encourage student to contact a teacher if they find a particular idea difficult.

- Ensure they have a well presented folder. Good organisational skills are key for coursework.
- Ensure they have all the equipment they need. It will be useful for the students to have a lab coat (full sleeves) as they will carry out practical with microbes.
- Coursework will have tight turn around time please discuss the importance of meeting deadlines.
- Proofread their coursework tasks.
- Encourage students to read widely around the topics when at home.
- Discuss issues with the student that they have met in Human Biology course with ethical, moral or social considerations with the aim of helping them to evaluate ideas.
- Encourage student to contact a teacher if they find a particular idea difficult.

Encourage them to complete past paper questions as part of their revision.

HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN?

- Encourage regular practice at home.
- Encourage them to perform in front of family and friends.
- Encourage participation in concerts and performances both inside and outside of school.
- Ask them to read their composition plans to you and to justify how and why their ideas meet the given brief.
- Ask them to play any initial melody ideas to you even if you are not musical, you will be able to tell if these ideas are coherent enough to sound like a tune!
- Ask them to talk about where they got their compositional influences from.
- Test them on their musical vocabulary and ask them to describe the main points of interest from each of the set works.

HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN?

- Ensure students have a well-organised folder containing all of their classwork, sorted into a logical order that is easily accessible and go through your child's Personalised Learning Checklists with them to talk through which elements of the specification they need to revisit
- Discuss philosophical questions and ethical issues with your child (e.g. views about euthanasia or business ethics– encourage students to 'teach' you what they have learnt)
- If possible, encourage access to the course textbooks or encourage students to borrow textbooks during their study periods. All can be found in the cupboards of G7 and G2.
- Discuss with students their progress, particularly their performance on milestone assessments.

HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN?

Please enquire as to whether your child's folder is neat and orderly. For each topic, it should contain a Personalised Learning Checklist (PLC) and a class pack completed up to the most recent topic. Please ask your child if they feel they have any topics missing and if they are not able to catch-up on the work independently or with classmates to book an appointment with their teacher for further support. Please also enquire as to whether your child has access to their Google Classroom (GC) page for their psychology group. The GC page will show all their homework assignments to date alongside deadlines. You could ask them how they have been using their supervised study periods at school and if they have been using the suggested activities posted in the supervised study GC pages (codes: Year 12: "ykbvyzb"; Year 13: "Iqhnwef"). Please encourage your child to be reading the sections of the textbook that accompany the topics recently covered in class. They may have their own copy of the textbook, or they can use the digital version found here www.illuminate.digital with the username: "SYATELY" and the password "STUDENT". You may also ask them how they are preparing for the final exams, even if they seem a long way off. This will involve reviewing their previous topics and making consolidation resources, such as mind maps or flashcards; they may also choose to attempt practice exam questions which can be found in the textbook, in their class packs or on the AQA psychology website here: https://www.aga.org.uk/subjects/psychology/as-and-a-level/psychology-7181-7182/assessment-resources

HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN?

Sociology students should keep their class resource packs in order and bring the appropriate folder to each lesson. Students should also purchase a revision guide to accompany each unit (usually priced at £1!) which is available from their class teachers. We recommend that students regularly re-visit content that has been taught, and that they have learnt. Active re-call might include concept maps, the use of revision 'flash-cards' and online platforms, such as tutor2u. We highlight recommend that students incorporate regular exam-style practice into supervised study and time at home. Essay questions could be planned, or part-written. Whole essays might be written and then submitted for additional feedback; we're happy to read over these and provide advice! Links to past exam questions are available via your child's Google Classroom page. Finally, we encourage all students to keep a close eye on world news events, since being able to relate what's going on around the world to what we discuss in class is a must in sociology. Bbc.co.uk/news is a useful starting point. We advise students to download a BBC news app on to their phone!

HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN?

Even if you don't speak a word of Spanish you can help:

- Test them on the meanings of Spanish words when they have to learn vocab or grammar.
- For longer pieces of writing, ask them to talk you through the plan of their work in English before they start to make them think about the structure of what they write.

• If they are doing reading or listening, get them to summarise what the text/extract is about in English – how fluently can they talk about it? Ask them what certain words mean – how spontaneously can they answer you?
