Homework Report Card Process

At Maiden Erlegh School, homework is a valued part of the learning journey in each subject, and is planned for as part of that curriculum. Homework is set to ensure students make the requisite progress and deepen their learning by providing activities which contribute to students:

- being engaged and enthusiastic about their courses
- developing good learning habits and cultivate self-discipline
- · becoming skilful, independent and resilient learners
- · committing to memory core knowledge, vocabulary and concepts
- consolidating knowledge and skills
- extending and deepening understanding
- · developing highly effective revision and rote learning skills

The vast majority of students complete all of their homework set, and submit this on time. However there will be occasions when a student genuinely forgets to complete their homework, and as of Monday 3 June, we will email home to let you know when this happened, and ask for the work to be completed. When a student frequently fails to submit their homework (three or more times), they will be placed on a subject homework report card to help them with their organisation. As of Monday 3 June, we will send an email home to let you know if this happens, and ask for your support.

If you would like help in supporting your son or daughter with homework, please note that we also run a homework club. Homework club runs from 3pm until 4.30 every Monday to Thursday, and is open to all students.
