## Year 8 Lego Mindstorm EV3 Challenge – Thursday 7 November 2019

Your child will have the opportunity to take part in an educational and enrichment activity at Maiden Erlegh School, hosted by Thales. Thales are one of our STEAM partners and they will be coming into school during lesson 2 and part of lesson 3 to deliver the LEGO MINDSTORMS EV3 Challenge to students. LEGO MINDSTORMS EV3 makes building, programming and commanding LEGO robots smarter, faster, and more fun than ever.

The challenge is designed to engage and enthuse students with a particular interest in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Design and Mathematics) and Computer Science. It is also designed to inspire future careers in STEAM and Computer Science and is ideally aimed at students who are already passionate about STEAM, but also students who may need a little more inspiration.
