19 th Century fiction and creative writing	Language Paper 1: Section A and B	Section A: Students are asked to read an extract from a 19 th Century novel and complete two small questions and two larger questions. Question 3 requires analysis of language and structure and question 4 asks students to explore settings, themes, ideas and events within the extract. Section B is a task asking them to write a creative piece based on a given idea of topic. Poetry	Literature Paper 2: Section B	Set texts: 15 poems they will need to know well enough to write about without having them in front of them.
