# DigiGirlz, Microsoft Campus, Thames Valley Park - Monday 25 November 2019

Your daughter will have the opportunity to take part in an educational and enrichment trip to Microsoft Campus, Thames Valley Park on Monday 25 November 2019.

<u>DigiGirlz</u> gives schools from across the UK the opportunity to bring eight Year 8 girls to Microsoft's UK Headquarters to learn about technology, hear from inspirational female speakers, connect with Microsoft employees, and participate in hands-on computer and technology workshops. The aim of DigiGirlz is to empower young girls to consider STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Design and Mathematics) careers and to inspire them. As this event aims to inspire the next generation of girls to consider pursuing STEAM subjects, this enrichment opportunity is aimed at girls who are already passionate about STEAM, but also girls who may need a little more inspiration.

This trip is free to students and they should meet under the covered way on Monday 25 November at 8:00am to register and for a prompt departure. We will travel by minibus to the Microsoft Campus at Thames Valley Park and participate in activities delivered by Microsoft as part of the DigiGirlz event. Lunch will be provided for students but they may wish to bring snacks and drinks with them. We will return back to Maiden Erlegh School at 16.30. Should our return be delayed, we will ask the students to contact you by phone. School rules will apply in regards to make up and jewellery. Once again, the advice is not to bring expensive equipment e.g. MP3 players, as the safety of the items cannot be guaranteed. Also they will not be covered by the school's insurance policy.

If you would like your daughter to be considered for this event, please complete and return the expression of interest slip below by **Thursday 7 November 2019**, clearly noting any food allergies or dietary requirements as we will need to provide these to Microsoft. There are only eight spaces available for this trip so names will be drawn from a hat once we have received more than eight applications. Successful students will be notified on **Monday 11 November 2019**.

Please note that prior to the event, girls attending DigiGirlz will need to ensure that they are familiar with the <u>MakeCode</u> website in order to be able to complete the activities on the day. Information can be found at <u>https://makecode.microbit.org/</u>.
