Year 11 Revision Corridor

We are pleased to share with you that the Year 11 revision corridor will begin week commencing **Monday 3 February 2020** with each department offering a bespoke programme of revision support and guidance. Subject departments have put together a programme of sessions for between 8-10 weeks lasting between 30 and 60 minutes to support students. The sessions have been designed to provide students with support with key topics and concepts, development of examination skills and/or securing specific grades.

The programme will run from Monday 3 February 2020 and there will be after school sessions every day until Friday 1 May 2020 across the key stage 4 curriculum. These sessions always prove to be popular with students. Please could I enlist your support in discussing the different sessions with your child and encouraging them to attend as many as possible so that students get the most out of the wealth of support, expertise and advice that is being offered by department experts.

Research tells us that the 'little and often' approach towards revision works well and by attending these sessions students will become more confident and resilient as they approach the summer examinations.
