Year 12 - Revised plans - Move from Year 12 into Year 13

We are writing to update you about our revised plans as we move from Year 12 into Year 13.

We were delighted to welcome so many students back this week who have benefited from seeing their teachers face to face and their fellow students. If you have not signed up and would like to, please email the school office mesoffice@maidenerleghtrust.org

The prelims that were scheduled for Thursday 25 June 2020 and Friday 26 June 2020, will now be held the week commencing 14 September 2020. We have taken this decision to move the examinations, so that all students have a fair chance to access their work and learning, enabling them to prepare thoroughly for these key assessments. Students will only be required to attend school for their examinations in assessment week.

As we are now in a period of wider opening, we have the opportunity to assess whilst students are in school, the topics that they feel confident with and those that we need to revisit. All departments will issue a personal learning checklist (PLC). Students can then check their prior learning and also plan for the content that will be covered in these examinations.

The results of these prelims will form the basis of the predicted grades that we report to UCAS. These grades will also be considered a key part of our progress data and would support our evidence for centre evidence grades if we should be called upon to report these again next summer to the exam boards.
