Materials that you will require for your Art and Photography Lessons in September.

Pencils, at least 3 different types HB, B and 2B are essential.

Coloured pencil crayons/ Watercolour and blend able coloured pencil crayons, if possible water-soluble coloured pencil crayons.

A Glue stick, your own rubber and ruler.

A sketchbook; You can purchase these in school on return in September the A3 sketchbooks cost £3.50 and it would be great if everyone could purchase them in the first week Please bring in £3.50 cash for buying a sketchbook

Photography students will need their own SD card to put into our cameras and their own card reader. Photography Sketchbooks are £8.50 you can buy these from the Art Department they are A3, black and last a long time. You might also need a couple of white writing pens to annotate your work in the black photography sketchbooks.
