Target Bullying Programme

Whilst bullying is very rare, we take all forms of bullying very seriously, when it does occur. The school will investigate and intervene when bullying takes place on school premises, on the journey to and from school (whilst students are wearing uniform), off site activities and whilst using school equipment.

We have high expectations of everyone in the school community, including parents, students and staff. As part of #TeamMaidenErlegh:

- Everyone will be respectful to each other
- Everyone will report abuse or bullying of another person
- The school will be proactive in preventing bullying
- Students will learn what bullying is and what to do to report it
- The school will run an Anti-Bullying Week every year
- Teachers are trained on the signs of bullying and how to listen to any student who feels they
 are being bullied

At school, we follow the 'All Together Programme', which is organised by the Anti Bullying Alliance and for the work we completed last year in proactively addressing bullying, we were awarded a Silver Award.
