Electric Scooters

We are keen to ensure the safety of all our students and have been asked by the local authority to ensure that you are aware of the legal position regarding electric scooters (e-scooters).

There is currently an ongoing government trial for the use of e-scooters in public areas, although this is only for specified areas of the country, of which Wokingham is **not** yet included. However there have been some reports of young people using e-scooters on public pavements in the borough. It is not yet legal for electric scooters to be used on public pavements or public highways and they should only be used on private land. Where e-scooters are used on private land, appropriate protective clothing such as helmets, elbow pads and knee pads should be used. Whilst this is an issue that is enforced by the Police, the Local Authority want to ensure that children and young people are safe and adhering to the law, as we do too.
