Update on Examinations

Whilst this is incredibly important for our students and parents in Years 10, 11 and 13, I felt it right to send the latest communication from Gavin Williamson, Secretary of State for Education to all parents. In his letter to the Head of OfQUAL, Mr Williamson has outlined his views on how he would like to see the grades for GCSE, A Levels and Vocational Qualifications being awarded this summer. It is important to state that this is not confirmation of how grades will be awarded but it does give us all an idea of what may, or may not, be in the consultation due to be sent out by OfQUAL shortly. Once I have received this consultation I will share it with all students, parents and staff.
