Year 11 and Year 13 Information Evening

As a result of the disruption to the education of students caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the government decided that exams could not be held in summer 2021 in a way which is, and which is perceived to be, fair.

The OFQUAL consultation was then launched, and decisions shared as to how grades would then be awarded this summer.
