### **Year 13 – End of Term Update**

We are writing to inform you of upcoming key dates for Year 13 students.

### **May Assessments: 10 – 21 May**

The assessment period will begin on Monday 10 May and finish on Friday 21 May. There will be no assessments on Thursday 13 and Friday 14 May as this is when Eid falls. Students will have study leave for this period of time and only need to attend school for their assessments. We ask that students please arrive 10 minutes prior to their assessment start time. The timetable for the assessments has been published on the Year 13 Google Classroom and a copy given to Year 13 tutors and to Mrs Rice in the private study area for students to access. Students with exam concessions in place will receive these as normal for the assessments. BTEC Business students will need to attend individual appointments/lessons during study leave, these will be arranged and communicated to the students via email. Students will receive marks for these assessments, these will be published on the parent app by June 18.

### **Leavers Day: 27 May**

Students will return to school after their assessments on Thursday 27 May for their final day. Students will be off timetable for this day, we ask that students please attend school in normal Sixth Form dress code.
