Indigo Resource Base

We are pleased to announce that Maiden Erlegh School has been awarded the provision of a Resource Base for Secondary School Students with Autism Spectrum Disorder and Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs by Wokingham Borough Council.

This will be based at the school and recognises the important work that our Inclusion Team already do in supporting all students. This also builds on the Purple Pathway Provision in Foundation and Violet College provision in Key Stage 4.

The resource base will open in September 2021, to 5 students in Year 7 and 5 more students will join each year, following consultation with Wokingham Borough Council, up to a maximum of 25. These students will benefit from a dedicated resource space, therapy room, sensory room and specialist SEND classroom. As well as benefiting from a specialist SEND teacher, they will also spend time, with support, in the mainstream classes.

We are very excited to expand our support for students with Special Educational Needs and deliver on our ethos of success for all. We believe that the facilities to be developed on the school site, will benefit and open up opportunities for all students.
