Year 13 – Post Assessment Plans

As you know, Year 13 students will have their final day in school during the current academic year on Thursday 10 June 2021. A level results will then be released on Tuesday 10 August 2021.

Following the last day in school, we would hope that students use the remainder of the summer to help prepare for the next stage of their studies at university or apprenticeship training. To help with this, we have put together a list of online courses and resources that students can use in the weeks ahead in the following categories:

Students can access all of these courses for free, although some courses, and particularly MOOCs, will charge a fee to provide a certificate for a course.
