Summer work Expectations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Please visit a gallery or museum.</b> You are required to see artwork/sculpture/photography first hand. If you find this difficult Visit Reading Museum it's free and in the centre of town. There is an Art Gallery and ceramic rooms. Take photographs of the artwork keep, tickets and write about your response to the work, scale, colour, and mood, what you liked about the work.</li> <li>• <b>Galleries in London include;</b> Tate Modern, Tate Britain, The V and A, The National Gallery, The National Portrait Gallery, The Saatchi Gallery. Most of these galleries are free and are fantastic resources.</li> <li>• <b>You might visit sculpture parks such as;</b> The Hannah Peschar Sculpture Garden, Churt Sculpture Park and Roche Court, New Art Centre.</li> <li>• <b>Create at least a 4 slide PowerPoint about the artwork that you saw in the gallery or museum.</b> This should include an image/several images of the work and some of descriptions that you noted to present to the group when you return to school. Please print the PowerPoint in colour if you can.</li> <li>• <b>Select an interesting object of your choice</b> this could be anything from a musical instrument, a building or a head of a member of your family.</li> <li>• <b>Draw/record with a camera the object from 10 different viewpoints</b> top, bottom, side, inside/outside, below, different angles, close up, magnified. Present your work on paper or in a sketchbook. Your work should include first hand drawings, photography and mixed media.</li> <li>• Bring your work into school on your first Art Lesson back.</li> <li>• <b>Watch some You Tube clips of “What do artists do all Day”</b> Anthony Gormley and Cornelia Parker are fantastic examples from this series of programmes.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ENJOY CREATING and looking at Art!!</b></p>
