Dear Parent/Guardian

Students bringing money to school

We have seen an increasing number of students bringing money into school with them recently.

Please can we remind you that we are a cashless school, and therefore students do not need to bring money onto the school site. We do appreciate, however, that some students may need to have some money with them to facilitate a journey home or may wish to visit the local shops before or after school.

In order to protect your child's money, we would therefore recommend that they do not bring more than £10 into school with them. If we notice that a student has a large sum of money on their person, a member of staff may talk with them about this, remove it from the child and place it in Reception for parents to collect. This will also help to ensure that large sums of money are not misplaced.
