## Time Slots for Mass Asymptomatic Testing in January

Following on from my letter last week regarding mass asymptomatic testing in January, we have revised the testing schedule slightly and have established timings for the days. This time the requirement is for only one test on site, and we will be staggering the students' return to ensure we can carry out the testing effectively. Students will be tested on one day and then return to school the following day and full details are laid out below. Please note this has been amended from the schedule sent last week.

We are strongly encouraging all students to come in and be tested, we want to be able to start the year without any cases in school so we can avoid any potential outbreaks, especially with the potentially more transmissible Omicron variant. During this first week of school, the following learning provision will be put in place:

- Work will be provided for all lessons whilst students are at home via Google Classroom
- Wherever possible these will be live lessons (some staff will be required in the testing centre so may not be able to carry out live lessons)
- In the morning/ afternoon that a year group is allocated for testing there will be no live lessons, but work will be set on Google Classroom

As you know, there have been issues with Tik Tok nationally and so I will be instructing staff to have their cameras off during the live lessons to protect them.

Please can I remind students that they need to be wearing a mask (unless exempt) when moving around in buildings. With the threat of the new variant, we need to do all we can to keep our community safe. A reminder that if your child does not have a face covering, they will be sent to Inclusion to get one, and this can be paid for on ParentPay.
