Pop-Up School – January 2022

In January there will be phased return to school due to the Lateral Flow Testing and Mr Gibson has already communicated the timings of this to you. As a result of this, we will be offering a Pop-Up school again between 4 and 6 January.

The Pop-Up provision is available for children of key workers and children who are deemed to fall into one of the vulnerable categories below:

1. Identified in Section 17 of the Children Act 1989 (CIN, CP, LAC, EHCPs)
2. Identified as "otherwise vulnerable" eg: Known to children's social care services
3. On the edge of children's social care services
4. In the process of being referred to children's services
5. Adopted or special guardianship order children
6. Those at risk of becoming NEET
7. Those living in temporary accommodation
8. Young carers
9. Those who may have difficulty engaging with remote education at home
10. Care leavers
11. Other eg: linked to mental health

Students attending this will be offered testing at the start of the day on Tuesday 4 January, they will then be able to join the Pop-Up School. Students attending this provision will be based in a computer room and completing work set on Google Classroom by their teachers or accessing live lessons online. They will be required to bring their own plug-in headphones. Please complete the survey below **before 9am on Friday 17 December** if you require a place and indicate which category your child falls into.
