Year 13 Supervised Study Changes – April 2022

I am writing to inform you that from Monday 25 April Year 13 will no longer have to attend their timetabled supervised study sessions and may study at home instead. We have introduced this change for several reasons: in response to student voice; to prepare those students planning to go to university in managing their time independently; and to help with revision. If students wish to use the study area, they are still able to, however they will need to sign in using the folders in the foyer of the common room. All students must continue to sign out after their last timetabled lesson of the day. Signing in and out are essential for safeguarding reasons, so that we know who is on the school site.

It is vital that Year 13 continue to attend their subject timetabled lessons. Many subjects have yet to complete the syllabus and will not complete this until Friday 20 May. In the final weeks there will be focus on examination technique, analysis of practice papers and a review of examiners comments. We are acutely aware that Year 13 students have experienced disruption to their A level and GCSE studies, therefore it is even more important they attend all timetabled lessons, to put them in the best possible position for their A Level examinations.

We will write to you again next term regarding arrangements for the last day and A level results day.
