Year 9 - Spotlight on Skills Sessions - Thursday 26 May

Your child will have the opportunity to take part in an educational and enrichment activity at Maiden Erlegh School, hosted by Thales. Thales are one of our STEAM partners and they will be coming into school on Thursday 26 May to deliver Spotlight on Skills sessions to students in Year 9 with an interest and enthusiasm in STEAM-related subjects and careers.

The session uses students' natural tendency to create and articulate their self-identity with adjectives to help them see themselves working happily and successfully in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Design or Mathematics (STEAM). Students will explore the day in a life of a Thales employee and the skills required for the workplace. There is also a team skills activity at the beginning of the session. The sessions are designed to inspire future careers in STEAM and is ideally aimed at students who are already passionate about STEAM, but also students who may need a little more inspiration.

Maiden Erlegh School has been allocated 50 spaces for this challenge and at no cost to students. Please note we expect students to wear full school uniform during the day. This activity will take place all day on Thursday 26 May and therefore it is the responsibility of the student to catch up with any missed class and home work. If there are more than 50 students who apply for a place in this workshop, names will be randomly selected. If your child has been successful in securing a place, a confirmation of place letter will be sent with further details. The deadline for completed online expression of interest forms is 5pm **Friday 6 May 2022** and the form can be accessed here.
