## Dear Parent/Guardian

## Years 10, 11 and 13 – Special Consideration in Public Examinations

I am writing to share with you the process for special consideration in public examinations for academic year 2021/22.

Special consideration may be awarded when a candidate has temporarily experienced illness, injury or some other event outside of their control which has impacted them at the time of the assessment.

It is applied only when the issue or event has had, or is reasonably likely to have had, a material effect on a candidate's ability to take an assessment (eg. absence from the examination) or demonstrate his or her normal level of attainment in an assessment.
