Year 11 - English Literature 19th Century Novel Choices (English Literature Paper 2)

Going into Year 11 in September, your son or daughter will study the 19th century novel which is their final set text for the English Literature GCSE.

Staff have chosen a 19th century novel for their classes from the list provided by Edexcel and all information about which novel your child is studying can be found in their Google Classroom. In September they will need a copy in the classroom and will use it to record their notes.

It is helpful if students have the same versions of texts for use in lessons and it is essential that the edition used is full and unabridged. Here are the editions we recommend:

Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde by Robert Louis Stevenson ISBN-13: 9781853260612 (Only students in Mrs Cripps' and Ms Terry's classes are studying this text.)
