Year 7 and Year 8 Disco – Friday 2 December 2022

In order to celebrate the wonderful start Year 7 and 8 have made at Maiden Erlegh School we have organised a disco for both year groups on Friday 2 December 2022, starting at 6pm and finishing at 8pm.

There are 143 places available for the disco which will be on a first come first served basis. In order to be able to run this event, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £2 per student towards the costs of the evening. Should your child wish to attend, please make the payment of £2 payable through ParentPay. This payment should be made by Monday 14 November 2022. Tickets purchased last year by the new Year 8 students, prior to this event being cancelled are still valid, this only applies if you have responded using the link in the previous letter that was sent before half term. If you have not responded or have informed us that your child no longer would like to attend, then your £2 payment will be refunded.

Students will not be expected to wear school uniform, but normal behaviour expectations will apply. School staff will be in attendance to supervise the event. Refreshments will be available throughout the evening, so students may wish to bring a small amount of money to purchase these also.

Should your child's medical circumstances have changed it is your duty to inform the school in writing or email <u>mesoffice@maidenerleghtrust.org</u> as soon as possible and before this event.

If your child is unable to attend this event due illness or to Covid-19 isolation, unfortunately we are unable to guarantee a refund, however we will endeavour to offer a full/partial refund if:

- Another student replaces your child's place for this event.
- The school is able to agree a full/partial refund from external agencies with whom the event is booked.

Payment should only be made if you are agreeing with the conditions set out in the Parent Agreement on the second page.
