The trip lasts for 5 days/4 nights and will leave on Monday morning and return on Friday evening.

The total cost for the week will be **£463** which includes full board accommodation, adventurous activities, instruction, equipment, and coach travel (by Horsemans) and insurance. To keep the cost of the trip down, students are required to bring their own sleeping bag and pillow for the accommodation. **The initial deposit of £63 must be paid by Friday 2 December 2022 which is payable through ParentPay. Payment is not required at this stage.** Should you have any problems with this financial contribution, please do not hesitate to contact Mr Bryant via the school office mesoffice@maidenerleghtrust.org If you are entitled to pupil premium, then you can indicate that you would like to use this money by ticking the box on the **Expression of Interest form.**

Please note that the cost of the trip is subject to change once we confirm final numbers with the coach company. If there are insufficient numbers for the trip, there may be no alternative but to cancel.

At the moment we are looking for expressions of interest to gauge student numbers for the residential trip as **we are limited to 170 student places.** **Please register your interest by completing the electronic Expression of Interest form below by the end of the school day on Wednesday 23 November 2022.** This does not guarantee that your child will go on this trip. In the event of an over subscription, a place on the trip will be allocated on meeting the deadline, behaviour record, attitude to learning and attendance. If these criteria do not discriminate, names will be drawn at random. If your child is successful and allocated a place on the trip a further letter will be sent out with payment details and deadlines.
