Year 11 - Easter 2023 – Revision Mornings

Over this Easter break, we are delighted to offer some staff led revision, to help boost your son/daughter's preparation for the forthcoming GCSE examinations.

The intensive revision mornings are offered and run by Maiden Erlegh's specialist teaching team, with a bespoke programme of work and support, to provide a positive start to each students individual revision plan.

Revision mornings will be offered during the week beginning Monday 3 April, booking via ParentPay will secure your place, **please note that places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis.**

The price per day is £37.50, and each day will run from 9:30am until 12:30pm.

Classes will be of 15 - 20 students, and each morning will require a minimum of 15 students to run. Please note that students will not be expected to wear school uniform on these days.

Places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If you have any queries relating to ParentPay please email ParentPay@maidenerleghtrust.org. We may be able to provide financial assistance for those students who are entitled to Pupil Premium funding. - Normal behaviour policies will apply and students will be removed if they do not follow this.
- Students are expected to bring in normal school equipment for the subject.
- The canteen will not be open so students will need to bring water / snacks for the sessions.
- Students will not be allowed off site during the time they are in the session.

Please ensure your child goes to the H Block at 9:20am, where they will be registered, ready for the session to start promptly at 9:30am.
