<p><b>You do not always know about Homework</b></p> <p>You felt you were not always informed about what homework your child had.</p>	<p>We are incredibly lucky to have supportive parents and therefore we want to help you help your child with their homework.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Review the use of Google Classroom for setting homework and logging this.</li><li>- Trial a system in the Bromcom app with a select number of parents and students to see if this helps.</li><li>- Reintroduce homework diaries which students can use as an additional measure to log homework.</li></ul>
<p><b>You do not always know how your child is getting on in school</b></p> <p>You want us review our reports and the information they provide.</p>	<p>We want parents to feel like they have the information they need about their child’s journey as school.</p> <p>Going forwards we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Evaluate the reports that we send home and make amendments to make them more user friendly.</li><li>- Have the process in place for September</li><li>- Ensure regular feedback is gained.</li></ul>
<p><b>Not enough opportunities for feeding back to the school</b></p> <p>You felt the that there is a difference between primary and secondary with regards the chance to feedback to the school</p>	<p>Whilst moving to ‘big school’ can be daunting for parents and students, we always want the parents to have a say in what we do – Good or bad!</p> <p>Going forwards we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Relaunch Slick and Slack quick feedback forms.</li><li>- We have changed the survey structure and will review this again.</li><li>- I have assigned the role of stakeholder relationships to a member of my senior team so they will be working on initiatives such as tours, focus groups etc.</li></ul>
