<b>Too much work is given at key times across the year</b>	<p>We never apologise for stretching you as much as we possibly can but you have raised that at times you feel overworked. We want to support you in managing your workload.</p> <p>Going forwards we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Ensure that no homework, unless revision focussed, will be set in the 2 weeks prior to PPEs and Prelims.</li><li>- Ensure that we review the calendar regularly to avoid burnout.</li></ul>
<b>We want feedback that is useful</b>	<p>Feedback is essential in every aspect of education so you can understand how you are progressing. Many of this goes unnoticed such as questioning and short quizzes. However, we note that you sometimes feel like some feedback is not helpful.</p> <p>Going forwards we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Ensure the DIRT work is re-embedded as part of the norm.</li><li>- Share best practice amongst staff on feedback</li><li>- Review the quality through our normal quality assurance processes.</li></ul>
<b>Google Classroom is not consistently used</b>	<p>Google Classroom is a great tool for submitting and setting work and when used effectively it can be excellent.</p> <p>Going forwards we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Set guidance for staff on how their Google Classroom should look.</li><li>- Ensure that Google Classrooms are checked and monitored.</li></ul>
