Year 9 into Year 10 - Mathematics Set Changes for September 2023

In order to ensure students, make maximum progress for the remainder of their Key Stage 4 course, we will be reviewing classes to ensure students are in groups with peers of the closest mathematical ability. Therefore, we will be making some class changes from the start of September which will be reflected in the new timetables issued at the start of next academic year.

The arrangement of the sets will be as follows (subject to change).

- The sets labelled 1 3 will follow the higher tier course.
- The set named 4 will continue to study the higher tier course but may be moved onto the foundation tier course if we feel that success at that level will be more achievable.
- The remaining groups on each year half will be following the foundation tier course but may be moved onto the higher tier course if we feel that success at this level is achievable.

All changes are made with the objective of enhancing the education of your child. Movement between sets will still be possible at regular intervals to accommodate students developing at different speeds and to place them in the correct set for optimum learning. Teacher assessment and results from end of the topic tests and termly assessments will inform the decisions to move students.
