On Thursday 9 November we will be having N-Act Theatre Company come to give a performance to our Year 7 - 9 students. Each student will have the opportunity to watch the performance which aims to educate them on key mental health topics such as suicide and self-harm.

Student's will follow the story of Denny who has written a blog to his 12-year-old self which he shares with the audience. Through a mixture of humour and pathos, the audience will learn from his experiences when growing up. Denny's story makes the audience think about perception, stigma, and how to recognise if someone is suffering, how we can help, and when to call in the professionals.
