Interrupted Learning

Context

From time-to-time, unforeseen events can result in the closure of our school on health and safety grounds. These can include adverse weather conditions. During any such event, we aim to ensure that:

Quality-first remote education aligns as closely as possible with our in-school provision in allowing learners to continue mastering the curriculum and make good progress

Guidance for teaching staff:

Colleagues will be notified via email and the school website by 7.15am at the latest.

Wherever possible, live lessons, via Google Meet, should take place as per the school timetable. Students should be notified via Google Classroom as to whether or not a 'live lesson' will take place.

Where it is not possible to hold a live lesson, work should be uploaded to Google Classroom in time for the start of the timetabled lesson.

There is no expectation that students will register with their tutor in the morning*

there is no expectation that teaching staff register attendance to a live lesson*

(*This guidance may change should prolonged school closure occur)

Should it not be possible for a teaching colleague to set work for their class(es) via Google Classroom, the Head of Department should be notified so that they can ensure that work is set.
