Year 11 - Examination Support Programme 2024

Year 11 Revision Surgeries and the Revision Corridor

This half term sees the launch of countless subject specific revision support sessions or revision surgeries, which are initially aimed at supporting Year 11 students in their forthcoming PPEs and then targeted at supporting them all the way to their public examinations. They will take place after school and are housed as a "revision corridor" mostly in the year groups' registration area on the G corridor.

These subject–specific sessions will be advertised to students through their tutors and available to view outside my office and on the Year 11 google classroom.

Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs)

There will be another period of PPEs taking place between Thursday 14 March and Thursday 28 March. They should be treated as examinations so that all the Year 11 students get the full benefit of such practice.

YEAR 11 Non Core PPE 2 Timetable – March/April 2024

Each non-core subject will set a paper, which is to be completed in a lesson during this PPE window.

Year 11 CORE PPE 2 runs from Thursday 14 March to Monday 18 March 2023 and will be held in examination venues.

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Examination Study Support Programme 2024

Monday 15 April to Tuesday 7 May	The timetable will carry on for all students as normal, but it will be a revision timetable with teachers leading revision sessions, rather than teaching new content.		
Wednesday 8 May	Year 11 Good Luck Day.		
Thursday 9 May to Wednesday 22 May	Students will have examinations during this period. The timetable will carry on for all students as normal, but it will be a revision timetable with teachers leading revision sessions and supporting structured revision. During this two-week period there will be some changes to the school day for Yr11: Extended Lunch 12:15 – 12:55 Earlier Finish at 1:55 Enabling students to use the remainder of the day for revision.		
Thursday 23 May to Wednesday 19 June	The timetable will cease. Students will attend school for examinations and pre-examination boosters only. Subject teachers will be available when lessons would ordinarily have been timetabled to offer guidance and support. Students should always be in full school uniform when they come on to the site during this period. If visiting a teacher, they should sign in at reception. There will also be revision center available for those who would prefer to revise in school more details about will follow		
Wednesday 26 June	Exams Contingency Day – all students should be available for examinations until this date, please do not book any holidays until after this date.		

Once I have completed the scheduling of the support for Year 11 students, I will make it available to all students and their parents/guardians.

Students should ensure that they attend all of their timetabled lessons in the run up to the final examinations until Wednesday 22 May, after which the timetable will be suspended.
