Year 13 - Exam Study Support

ILPs (Individual Learning Plans) - Monday 15 to Thursday 25 April & 29 Monday 29 April

During the first two weeks after the Easter break, all Year 13 students will have the opportunity to meet with their tutor for a private 1:1 appointment. The focus of this meeting will be to support students with their final preparations for the summer examinations. Tutors will be asking students to share with them how they have been revising, how effective they feel it has been, and offering advice, as appropriate, to improve revision skills, techniques and schedules. It will also provide an important opportunity for students to discuss any support that they feel they need. Students will need to book an appointment directly with their tutor, via their tutor Google Classroom, or their tutor's preferred method.

During these dates, students do not need to attend morning registration. Should they choose to come in before their first timetabled lesson of the day, they are welcome to, but they will need to sign in using the folder in the foyer of the common room. This is for safeguarding reasons, so that we have an accurate record of who is on the school site.

Students are expected to attend assembly on Friday 26 April from 8.30-8.50am. There will not be an assembly on Friday 19 April.

Exam Ready Assembly - Friday 26 April

All Year 13 students must attend assembly on this day as Mrs Morgan, deputy headteacher, will be reminding students of the JCQ examination rules, ahead of their examinations commencing.

Exam Booster Sessions

There are many sessions being run to support students immediately prior to their examinations. The schedule will be shared with parents/guardians and students after Easter. We strongly recommend that students attend these sessions.
