Year 7 - Maths Assessment January 2025

As part of our ongoing commitment to monitoring and supporting the progress of all students, we regularly assess students through both formal assessments and end of topic tests.

These assessments help us review student progress, identify strengths and address areas for development, ensuring that each student is both supported and challenged throughout the year. We regularly review the classes themselves to ensure that every student is placed in the most suitable group for their needs, allowing us to provide appropriate support and challenge for each student.

End of topic tests are regularly completed in lessons can be found in maths books. Your child will have already completed several of these. Directed Independent Reflection Time (DIRT) is then provided for students to improve on weak areas before moving onto the next topic.

The first Year 7 Maths Assessment will take place during the week commencing Monday 13 January 2025. It will be a 55-minute, non-calculator paper covering the topics taught in Year 7 so far. To help students prepare, a revision list has been posted on the Year 7 Whole Year Maths 24-25 Google Classroom (code: tdut4hx). We recommend that students spend some time reviewing the revision list and select 3-5 topics to focus on. A good place to start is to review end of topic tests and the revision list to decide weak topics to focus on.

You will also find suggestions for useful websites and resources on Google Classroom. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's maths teacher.
