When students return after the Easter break, we will return with a clear focus on revision and final preparation for the public examinations.

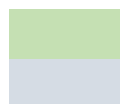
#### Public Examinations and Examination Study Support

From Monday 12 May until 17 June, we will move to a period of study support and home study. Each subject is offering bespoke lessons and exam boosters, as outlined below. We would expect all Year 11 students to attend all of these sessions below which are run by their teachers who are highly experienced at preparing students for GCSE and BTEC examinations.

When students are not in an examination or study lesson, they should use their time to study at home.

A **study lesson** is a planned session with a specific focus on areas that need to be fully mastered or for students who are sitting on specific grade boundaries. We expect these sessions to be fully attended

A **booster** or drop-in session last for approximately 30 minutes before an examination starts and is full of hints and tips for the forthcoming examination. Attendance to these whilst strongly recommended is optional
