Terms and Conditions

Thank you for allowing your son/daughter to take part in this school fundraising event.

Colour paint is vegan and vegetarian.

By purchasing a ticket, you give your unconditional consent to your son/daughter participating in the Colour Run scheduled to take place on the 11 June or an alternative date if so rearranged and confirm that you have read and understood these Terms and Conditions:

1. You confirm that your child is healthy and fit enough (mentally and physically) to complete the event and that you will inform the school immediately if this changes between the time of ticket purchase and the event, so that your son/daughter may be withdrawn (in which case a refund will be given).
2. You accept all the risks of your child participating in the event including but not limited to any accidents, slips, falls, negligent acts of other participants and you confirm that you understand that participating is a potentially hazardous activity although nothing herein is intended to limit liability for injury resulting from negligence by Maiden Erlegh School. (The event will be supervised by members of staff and first aiders will be available in case of need.)
3. You accept the risks of any damage to your child's clothing during their participation in this event.
4. Maiden Erlegh School holds the right to cancel or reschedule the event at its absolute discretion in the event of poor weather or other emergency.
5. Maiden Erlegh School has the right to remove participants at its absolute discretion if such action is considered necessary for safety reasons or the proper enjoyment of the event by other participants or for other reasonable reason.
6. We expect the same high standards of behaviour during the Colour Run as with other school events. Students acting in a dangerous or inappropriate manner may be removed from the event and given consequences in line with Maiden Erlegh School Behaviour for Learning Policy.
7. You agree that Maiden Erlegh School may take photographs and/or videos of your child during the event and may use such images for media use e.g. the school website, X or Facebook feed and/or local newspapers.
8. You agree that purchased tickets cannot be sold or given to other students.
9. Refunds will only be available subject to 2. above or other reason of cancellation of the event by Maiden Erlegh School.
