Top tips:

- **Keep up with emails, phone calls, & letters** from sixth forms/colleges/employers.
- **Contact schools & colleges BEFORE** the end of term with any questions.
- **Check enrolment** procedures for each college / sixth form.
- **If you have secured an apprenticeship** – check procedures for informing the employer of your results / next steps – **BEFORE** GCSE Results Day + ensure you sign an apprenticeship employment contract.
- **Send** information to sixth forms/colleges/employers- as required before / on GCSE Results Day.
- **Confirm and decline places** on GCSE Results Day.
